

The Rotary Club of Aberdeen Associate Membership Scheme

The Rotary Club of Aberdeen has launched a new trial membership scheme to enable individuals who may be interested in finding out more about Rotary to become Associate members.

Associate membership allows an individual to become acquainted with Rotary, its members, its programmes and projects. The Associate member can attend as many meetings as practicable, attend social functions and participate in community and fund raising activities, with the ultimate aim of becoming a full member in due course.

Membership Convener Brian Gill said: "We believe there are a large number of individuals who wish to know more about, or get involved in Rotary, but through pressure of work, or other time constraints, cannot commit sufficient time for total involvement. As a club we would like these people to get involved and to see what Rotary has to offer, as this often fits in with their own ethos of commitment and responsibility within the local community."

Associate members are not required to pay any annual fees, nor are they entitled to hold any club officer position but they are encouraged to work within club committees.

Meetings are held in the Royal Northern and University Club, Albyn Place each Tuesday (12.50 – 14.00) and the cost of the lunch is currently £14.
