

The Rotary Club of Aberdeen Corporate Membership Scheme

The Rotary Club of Aberdeen has launched a new membership scheme to enable business leaders and other organisations who are interested in joining Rotary to become corporate members.

Corporate membership entitles up to four members of an organisation to become members. The corporate members can then attend as many meetings as practicable, attend social functions and participate in community and fund raising activities. Corporate members will be allocated positions on club committees.

Membership Convener Brian Gill said: "There are a great number of business leaders and other organisations who we believe would be interested in joining Rotary, but through pressure of work cannot commit sufficient time for total involvement. As a club we have been contacted by many organisations who want to get involved, as it fits in with their ethos of commitment and responsibility within the local community. This is the fundamental reason for us launching our corporate membership scheme."

Annual fees are currently £125pa for the first member in each organization and £62.50pa for all subsequent members. Meetings are held in the Royal Northern and University Club, Albyn Place each Tuesday (12.50 – 14.00) and the cost of the lunch is currently £14.
