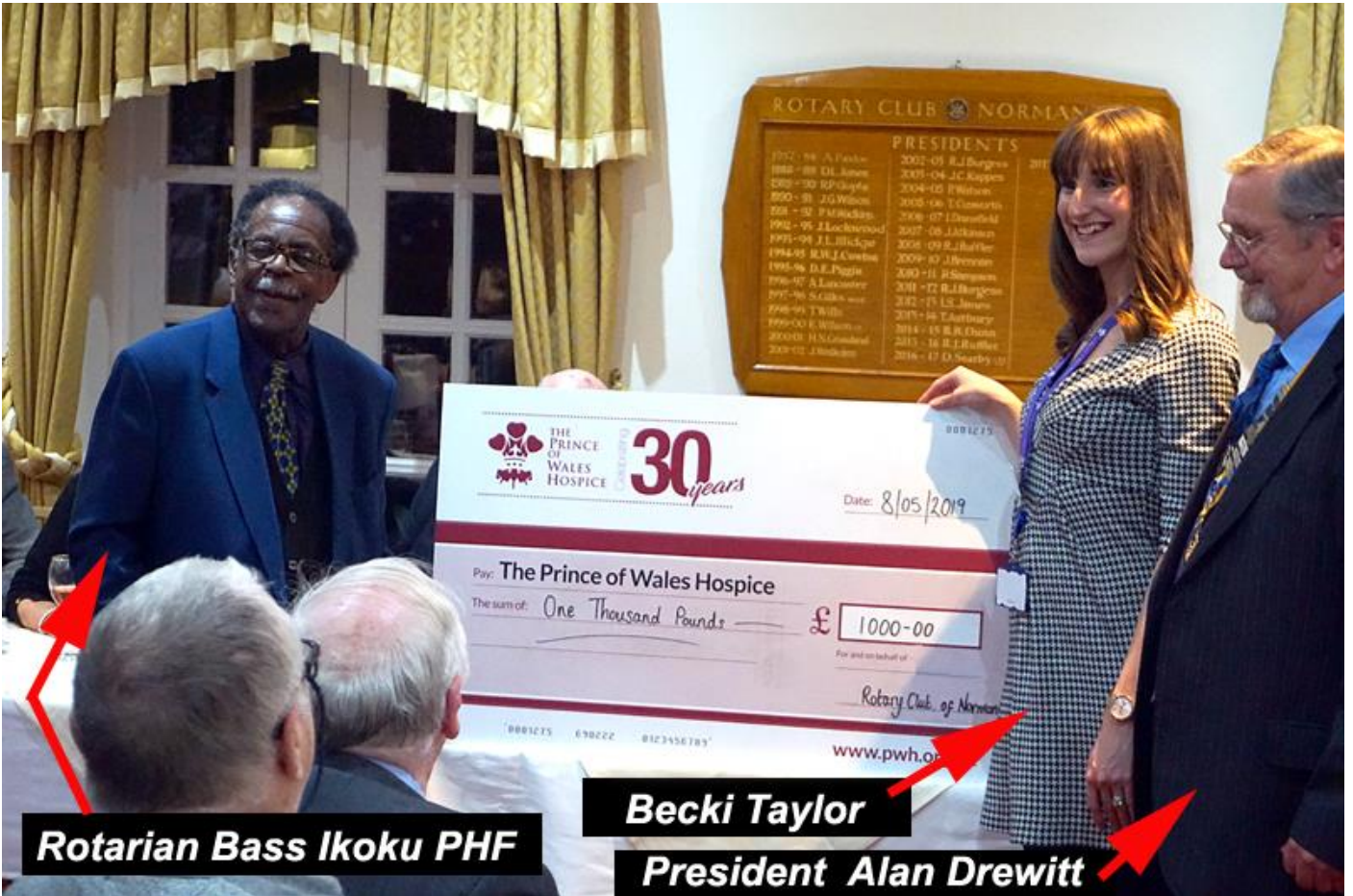


Presenting of Charity Band Concert Cheques
