Rules of the Rotary Club of Basingstoke for Friends of Rotary

1. Membership is open to anyone over the age of 18 subject to the following:
 - a) The completion of an application form for Friends of Basingstoke Rotary Club.
 - b) The approval of Basingstoke Rotary Club is obtained in the same way that a full member's application is processed prior to he/she joining the Rotary Club.
 - c) A subscription of £12 per annum pro rata is payable to Basingstoke Rotary Club.
 - d) Membership is for 12 months based on the existing Rotary Year i.e. 1 July to 30 June.
 - e) Prospective 'Friends' can apply for membership at any time during the Rotary Year.
 - f) Membership is subject to renewal on an annual basis.

2. Membership will entitle a 'Friend' to the following:
 - a) Attend club meetings, social, and fund-raising events except business and committee meetings.
 - b) By invitation be part of the organisation team of any social or fund-raising event.
 - c) Friends will be expected to pay their own meal costs.
 - d) The attendance of Friends at club meetings will be subject to the same rules that are exercised by the Club Attendance Officer for full members of Basingstoke Rotary Club.
 - e) If attendance at a meeting is requested and the Club Attendance Officer includes that Friend in the meal numbers but the Friend fails to attend then the Friend will be expected to reimburse Basingstoke Rotary Club for the meal cost if any cost was incurred.

3. Membership of Friends of Basingstoke Rotary Club will not entitle a person to the following:
 - a) Vote at any meeting on any subject.
 - b) Speak on any subject at a meeting unless requested by the Club President.
 - c) Bring a guest to any meeting without the approval in advance of a Club Officer i.e. President, President-Elect, Immediate Past President, Secretary, Treasurer.
 - d) Stand for any Office of Basingstoke Rotary Club.
 - e) Undertake and be responsible for any duty hitherto undertaken by a Member of Basingstoke Rotary Club at any meeting.
 - f) Attend any Rotary District meeting, Rotary Regional Meeting, Rotary Conference.
