Outside the arena, there will be lots of other entertainment for children, including a climbing tower, Punch and Judy, animal farm, bouncy castle, sumo wrestling and a mini-funfair.

There will also be a whole range of stalls, exhibits and country activities that you would expect to find at a village festival, many of which are run by local clubs and societies.

This year we are planning a **Fun Dog Show**, and there will also be a return of the popular display of classic motor vehicles and stationary engines.

Refreshments for all ages will be well catered for. There will be freshly cooked burgers and sausages, home baked cakes, soft drinks, teas and ice cream. When you're ready to take the weight off your feet, you can sit down in the Beer Tent and relax.
